- (1) Recommendation for title: Wind Speed Characterization in Cakung Jakarta
- (2) In the manuscript, the authors use the pronoun “we”. In scientific writing, pronouns should refer to the research. The author could replace the word “we” with “the research” or “in this research”.
- (3) The author expected that this research could contribute to the development of wind power plants in the industrial complex. However, there is a lack of information about the minimum wind speed and other parameters needed to generate electrical power
- (4) Figure 5 shows the weather station positions; however, the symbol of the weather station positions isn’t contrasted enough. Please provide the latitude and the longitude for each weather station position.
- (5) The paragraph after Figure 5 mention that the data collection is carried out for one to two weeks. Why the duration of data collection is not the same? Let’s say, for two weeks.
- (6) In this research, an air balloon was also used to collect the wind speed data. Is the position the same as the weather station?
- (7) Figure 10 shows the wind speed measurement at 8 locations. To get a better comparison, Figure 10 should be added with graphical data from the Global Wind Atlas.
- (8) If the authors could provide point (3), the manuscript would have better analysis and conclusion. The existing conclusion only resumes the experiment data. The manuscript has not adopted the experiment result as a consideration to build wind power plants in the industrial complex.
