**Hypermobility (travel)** : Hypermobile travellers are highly mobile individuals who take frequent trips, often over great distances. They account for a large share of the overall kilometres travelled, especially by air.

**Temporal Distance (time)** : Temporal distance refers to distance in time. Something that is temporally near is something near in time, whereas something that is temporally distant is far in time.

**Spatial Distance (physical space)** : Spatial distance is the physical distance at which the events are taking place from each other. If the event, is taking place near then it is being processed on a low level. If the event is taking place in another state, then it is processed on a high level

**Construal Level (distances)** : Social distance is the measure of space between two or more social groups or individuals. Social distance is more about the feeling of the people within the group and how they interact with other group members.
