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ABSTRACT

Therefore, this research on Portrayal of Gender Roles in Marriage in The Movie “Hijab” (2015) is necessary to see how men and women are being portrayed in the movie, which could bring impact to the viewer on how they see gender. The result of the study then revealed that the portrayal of gender roles in the movie “Hijab” is still highly stereotypical which confirmed by the three sources, that women are still placed in the domestic realm.
